HABcore receives \$10K grant from Tower Hill Church

RED BANK — HABcore Inc., a nonprofit providing supportive housing for the homeless and disabled, is the recipient of a grant of more than \$10,000 from the “Vision for the Hill” program of the First Presbyterian Church at Red Bank (Tower Hill Church).

The grant will be used for maintenance projects at HABcore boarding homes and independent living apartments in Red Bank and Asbury Park. The projects range from replacing water lines to installing new water heaters and flooring. Steve Heisman, executive director of HABcore, said in a press release.
